

Summit Point Motorsports Park COVID-19 Guidelines

Updated March 24, 2021

GENERAL RULES

All persons are asked to continue to practice social distancing guidelines of at least six feet between individuals who do not reside together.

All persons must wear proper personal protection equipment (PPE) throughout the park, including a face mask that covers their nose & mouth when in the presence of individuals whom you do not reside with.

Interior spaces will have clearly posted signs limiting maximum occupancy. All persons must abide by the occupancy limits.

Additional signage describing proper cleaning and hygiene guidelines will be posted.

All common areas such as point of sale equipment, doorknobs, light switches, buttons, table surfaces, and all other commonly touched surfaces will be frequently cleaned and sanitized.

Where possible doors and windows will remain open to improve ventilation.

PERSONAL SCREENING

If you have had exposure to someone with COVID-19 you should stay home.

If you have any of the following symptoms you should stay home.

- A cough, shortness of breath, or sore throat
- A fever in the last 48 hours
- New loss of taste or smell
- Had vomiting or diarrhea in the last 24 hours
- A current temperature over 100 degrees
- Exhibiting any other COVID-19 symptoms

ATTENDANCE

Spectators are now allowed to attend selected events. See our website calendar or check with individual event organizers to see if the event you are interested in is open to spectators.

Participants are currently not restricted in regards to the number of crew and support personnel that they may bring.

NOTE: Due to individual insurance policies and club requirements some events may still be restricted. This may include number of crew and support personnel allowed. This may also prohibit or restrict the number of spectators in attendance.
